



## S2: ABC Tool



Script: I bet you are asking yourself, what is an ABC Tool?

Script: An ABC Tool is an organized repository that provides a way to create and store different levels for plan and policy documents, links, pages, and other types of on the job content.

Script: Some of the common benefits of an ABC tool include:

- Centralized Content
- Simple navigation for end users by page, links and more
- Reduce Knowledge Gaps
- Customer Satisfaction
- Improve Productivity
- Ease of Use
- Quicker Problem-Solving **for faster access to information**


### S4: Operations National ABC Tool





Script: Accessing the ABC Tool is simple!
